D. Houses are either temporary **T** or permanent **P**. Below given are pictures of some houses. Pick their correct name from the Pick-up Point and write along.

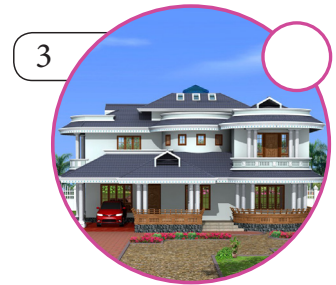
Pick-up point- Tent, Flat, Caravan, Bungalow, House Boat



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
