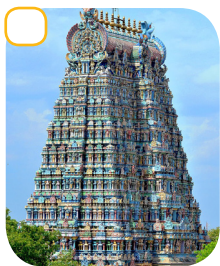

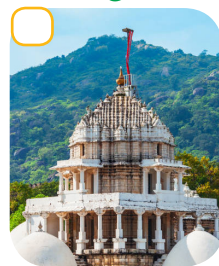

- A.** One of the largest temple complexes of India, this famous temple in Madurai has 12 gateways, known as gopurams.
- B.** Built in red sandstone with an extensive use of white marble, this mosque in Delhi was built by Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan.
- C.** Buddhist monument that preserved the sacred relics.
- D.** Officially known by the name Harmandir Sahib, this Gurudwara in Amritsar is one of the most revered pilgrimages.
- E.** This church, located near Panaji, Goa, comprises the mortal remains of St. Francis Xavier.
- F.** Located in Mount Abu, Rajasthan, these five legendary marble temples are a sacred pilgrimage place of the Jains.
- G.** The oldest existing synagogue among the Commonwealth countries of the world.
