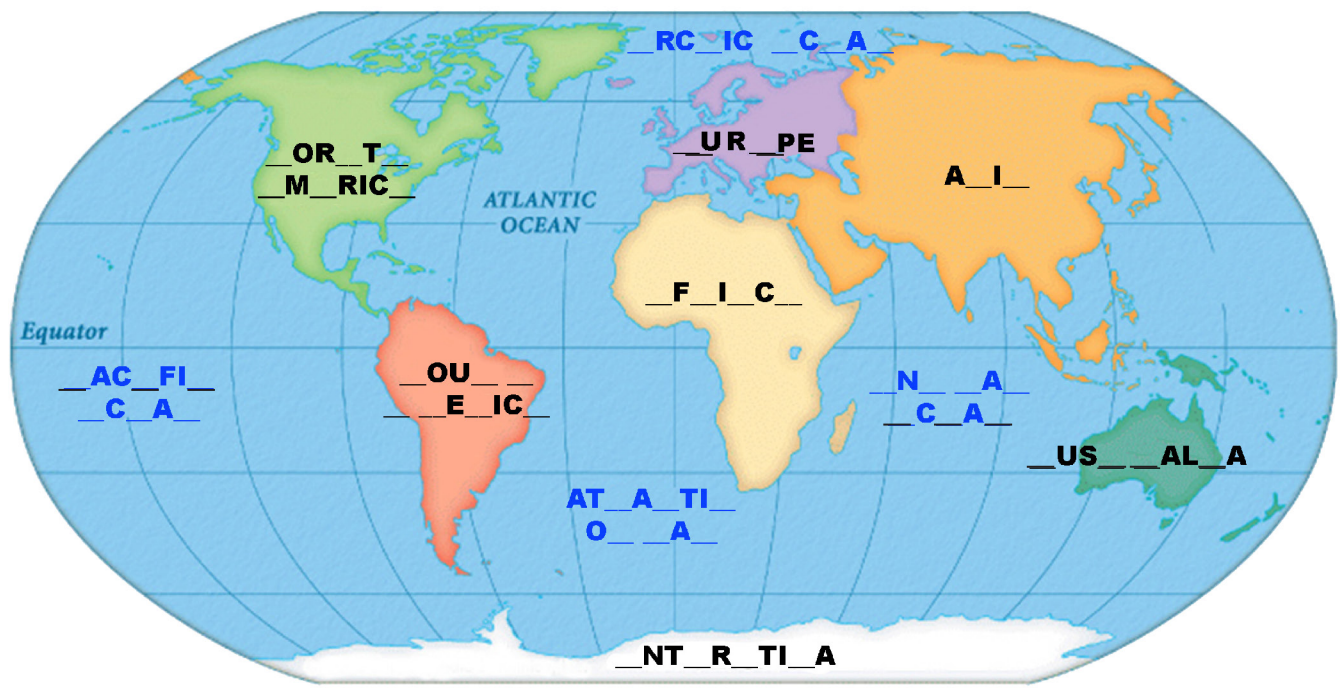

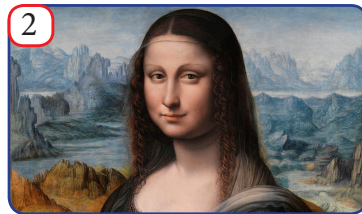
C. These artists painted masterpieces which are remembered till date. Know about their paintings and name them with the help of the Pick-up point.

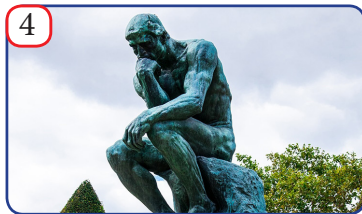
