 In a horror sequence of destruction, terrorists hijacked two airlines and crashed them into the World Trade Center in a coordinated series of attacks on Sep. 11 that brought down the twin towers. ⑦

All flights were grounded at Lindberg Field as the nation's airline was shut down in the wake of what appeared to be coordinated terrorist attacks in New York and Washington. Security was heightened at government and military facilities around the country, and some downtown office buildings were evacuated. ⑧
