- He is most known for commanding the Royalist Cavalry during the English Civil War. He is the German prince who joined the army at the age of 14
- The greatest sword fighter of his time who survived 60 duels. He is also known as the 'Sword Saint'. He is the best known samurai in Japanese history.
- His reign began somewhere around 490 BC. He is known for his heroic sacrifice at the battle of Thermopylae while trying to prevent the Persians from moving towards Athens.
- He was born in 356 BC. His early years were spent under the tutelage of the philosopher Aristotle. His early military career was spent releasing Greece from the grasp of the Persians.
- He is revered as the hero who returned Jerusalem into muslim hands. He was trained as a soldier by his uncle.
