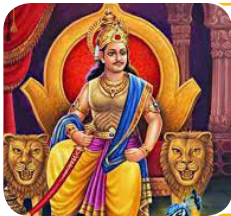

A. Name the following empires after going through their details.



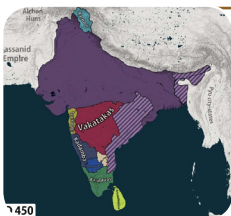
This empire was founded in 322 BC by Chandra Gupta Maurya. It was ruled from 321 to 185 BC and is known as an Iron-age Historical Power in the ancient world.



This empire was founded and consolidated by Chhatrapati Shivaji Bhosle. It existed from 1674 to 1818 and was known as Indian imperial power. They are credited for the re-establishment of Hindu rule in India.



This dynasty was one of the longest ruling dynasties in southern India. The dynasty was governed until the 13 century A.D. The kings of this dynasty were passionate builders and visualized temples not as places of worship but as economic centres.



This empire was an ancient Indian empire that existed from approximately 320 to 550 CE. This period laid a foundation of many inventions and discoveries in science, technology, astronomy and religion and was termed the 'Golden Age of India.'



This empire is named after its capital city. It lasted until 1646 although its power declined after a major military defeat in 1565 by the Deccan Sultanates. This empire is referred to as the 'Kingdom of Bisnagar' by the Portuguese.



This was a Muslim dynasty of Turkic-Khaloy origin. They ruled a large part of South-Asia between 1290 and 1320. They were the second dynasty to rule Delhi.
